



Ornament 2013

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This little Christmas ornament is our gift to you for 2013.

The model was stitched in red and green on white linen. It would also look lovely on natural linen, with white threads.

A perfect way to use up those leftover threads and bits of linen/aida.

Design Area: (29 x 29 stitches)
2 ' x 2 ' / 5,2 x 5,2 cm on 14 ct aida / 28 ct linen

The model was stitched on 28 ct white linen with one strand of DMC cebelia thread size 20. Of course you are welcome to use regular embroidery floss, aida, or any other color or material of your choice.

1. Start by stitching both designs.
2. Pull threads on each side (I pulled the 5 th), fold the mitred corners and pin in place.
3. Place both squares together and lightly stitch with a matching thread the sides to form a square. Add a bit of polyester filling if you wish to make a fluffy ornament. You could also add a cardboard square for a more stiff look.
4. Make a twisted rope with 2 x 1 meter strand of Cebelia (embroidery floss), then sew it with tiny stitches to the sides of the ornament and finish it off by making a loop for hanging.

About the chart :

This chart is perfect for filet crochet, cross stitch, beads, weaving, afghan crochet throws, etc....

You can easily add some colors, or variegated threads in your work to add a little variety.
