



Christmas 2016

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Stitch a cute little ornament for your Christmas tree, or use the pattern to make a pin cushion, lavender bag, etc...

This pattern was inspired by a design in the December 1889 edition of the French magazine 'La mode illustrée'.

The model was stitched on 28 ct natural linen, with DMC perle cotton size 8.



Materials

- . 28 ct linen
- . Perle size 8 (or embroidery floss)
- . A small ribbon
- . Some polyester fill
- . Sewing thread

Instructions

- . Stitch the pattern twice
- . Pull the 5th thread from the finished embroidery.
- . Fold mitered corners, secure with pins.
- . Discretely stitch up the ornament with a color coordinated sewing thread, attach the ribbon and stuff with polyester fill.

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If stitched on 28 ct linen/ 14 ct aida the ornament will measure :
3" x 3" / 7,5 x 7,5 cm

Tips

I recommend 28 ct linen, but you can use other sizes too.

This little ornament is perfect for using up leftover linen, and embroidery floss.
