



Müller 312

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This small floral pattern is hand drawn in pencil on a thick, gridded paper, which was then glued on a thicker card. The pattern is numbered on the top with N° 312, and on the back side the word *Müller* written in blue (ballpoint?) pen.

The person who drew this pattern also added some extra lines in the grids to divide them into smaller squares. There are some (ballpen?) markings on the chart, and numbers, which I presume were added later on, as well as some needle pricks, which would coincide with a stitcher poking the card to keep track of where they are on the pattern.



Design Area: 72 x 42 stitches

If stitched on 28ct linen/ 14ct aida the pattern will measure:

5,14" x 3" / 13 x 7,6 cm

On 28ct linen/14ct aida use two strands of embroidery floss for the cross stitch.

The pattern is presented in two versions. One as the original with just color blocks so you can choose the threads of your choice, and another with some suggestions in DMC embroidery threads.

Such a small project should be stitched using the threads you already own, and it is perfectly fine to mix different brands, such as DMC and Anchor.

Counted patterns are not just limited to cross stitch, they can also be used for other crafts such as mosaic, or diamond painting.

Tips

It is always nice to add a little texture to an embroidery project, either by using different types of threads (wool/cotton/silk), or by stitching some details in petit point, or replacing some of the stitches with beads.
