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A sweet little angel to use as an ornament, picture, card, etc...

This little design can easily be adapted to suit your Christmas color scheme by changing the color of the gown, hair, or other details.

+	DMC 5200	snow white (you can blend in a thread of Kreinik filament 001 silver, or 032 pearl)
K	DMC 434	brown
1	DMC 948	skin color

L	DMC 972	canary
♦	DMC 3820	old gold

DMC 972 canary (or metallic gold)

Linen

28 ct vintage/ natural linen

<u>Instructions</u>:

Use two strands of floss for the embroidery, and one strand for the back stitch.

This little angel has a lot of back stitch which gives it character, but you need to be extra careful to keep it nice and crisp.

Start by stitching all the cross stitch, half cross stitch, and petit point for the face and hands.

Next, use a sharp needle and do the backstitch with a single thread of black for the details, and yellow (or gold) for the little sparkles.

Just for fun, why not add some gold beads to the gown, or use some metallic threads.

Now, if you really do not feel comfortable with petit point stitches, then just go ahead and use regular cross stitch... it will still look lovely!
